ADOPT-A-SPOT GUIDELINES

- All tasks/projects should benefit the majority of area/spot users
- All tasks/projects must be completed only during daylight hours to ensure the safety of all involved
- Adopters must notify the Borough's Clean Communities Coordinator no less than five (5) business days prior to a task/project day
- * Adopters should notify the Borough's Clean Communities Coordinator of any vandalism or potential health/safety hazards
- Adopters may not modify or add to the existing landscape or site design plan without permission from the Borough
- Adopters must abide by all state and local laws, rules and regulations, all written and verbal guidelines as well as directions and instructions from the Borough and its Clean Communities Coordinator
- The Borough may contact adopters regarding special project
- $extstyle ag{The Borough will provide limited supplies to the adopters}$
- Adopters should not pick-up materials that they suspect may be hazardous needles, bloody objects or drug paraphernalia (Please contact the Borough is these conditions exist)
- Please recycle whenever possible The three (3) main types of recyclables are:
 - "Co-Mingle", which consists of plastic bottles, cans and glass

- o Paper and Cardboard
- Vegetation
- Adopters must contact the Clean Communities Coordinator prior to a task/project to receive instructions on disposing of garbage/recycling
- 🚏 Power tools and spray/chemicals are strictly prohibited
- 🕈 Adopters are to lift any and all heavy objects with caution
- Wear light or bright clothing, hard soled shoes and sturdy work gloves
- 🚏 Use sun block and stay hydrated
- The cautious of animals and insects, noxious weeds, glass, barbed wire, pipes and sharp objects and unexpected holes or ditches.
- The is the responsibility of the adopter's contact person to make all volunteers aware of these guidelines
- Tupon completion of a task/project day adopters are required to submit a "Follow-Up Report" to the Borough's Clean Communities Coordinator within five (5) business days. A master copy of the report is provided in the Volunteer Packet, additional blank copies can be made by the adopters as necessary.
