#### **Dear Contractor:**

We have prepared the following report to outline the guidelines which should be followed to assure the proper backfilling of the street openings in the Borough of Lodi.

Roadway excavations should be backfilled with all new material consisting of either dense graded aggregate (DGA), "borrow excavation" as defined by the current (2001) US Customary English Units version of the Department of Transportation's "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction", Bank run sand or stone dust.

Recycled concrete aggregate (RCA) can also be used as backfill, however, the "consistency" of this material can vary and if it is to be utilized the material brought on site would need to be inspected to assure that there was sufficient "dust" to assure proper compaction during backfilling.

Backfilling should be undertaken, again, in conformity with the current State of New Jersey Department of Transportation "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction: which require that the backfill be compacted in 6" lifts.

The pavement restoration should consist of 5"-6" of bituminous concrete stabilized base pavement mix 1-2" of bituminous concrete surface pavement mix 1-5.

Prior to the installation of the payment, the excavation should be "saw cut" to assure neat lines and a proper "butt" joint. The pavement should also be profiled so that the surface pavement "meets" the existing roadway pavement at the excavation limits.

When the stabilized base pavement is installed it should be given a sufficient opportunity (2-3 weeks) to "settle" before the surface pavement is installed.

When the surface pavement is installed both the stabilized base pavement and the limits of the excavation including the profiled areas should have a tack coat installed. Again the materials and methods of construction for the stabilized base and surface pavement installation should follow the current State of New Jersey "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction. Please be aware however, that under those specifications the designation of bituminous concrete has been changed to "hot mix asphalt".
